INVITATION

On behalf of Rare Breeds International (RBI), the National Institute of Animal Husbandry (NIAH; Hanoi, Vietnam) is pleased to invite you and your colleagues to the 7th Global Conference on the Conservation of Domestic Animal Genetic Resources to be held in Hanoi, Vietnam in September 2008.

Past RBI global conferences have brought scientists and conservationists together with one common goal – the conservation of global farm animal genetic resources – and the proceedings of these meetings have become valuable references on the characterisation and management of Animal Genetic resources.

The conference is part of a series of conferences, started in 1989 in United Kingdom and held in every third year typically in a region that is rich in Animal Genetic Resources (AnGR).
